Forms also can be submitted manually by paying fee in Padhar Hospital by Cash or Demand Draft of Rs.500/- in favour of "School/College of Nursing Padhar Hospital" payable at Padhar Branch or online transfer (UTR no. required).

2. Application must filled completely and submitted with accurate address, set of attested photocopies and medical certificate from registered medical practitioner. Late submission will not be entertained. No changes can be made in an application form once its submitted.
3. The College does not take any responsibilities for postal delay / losses of application form. The proof of posting will not be accepted as proof of delivery or receipt in case of delay.
4. If any certificates are in a language other than English or Hindi, the candidates are advised to notarize the document in English.
5. Student selection for college will depend on students' performance in entrance exam. The exam will be in MCQ format of 100 marks for 2 hours in English medium Subjects including General Knowledge, English & Bible (for Christian candidates), an interview will be conducted after exam. Final decision will be taken by State Nursing Council (in case of non-eligibility)
6. If a candidate is found to have furnished false information or certificate etc. admission will be cancelled and no refund of fees will be given.
7. The list of selected candidate will be displayed on the College Notice board.
8. Selected candidates have to present themselves on given date for joining with original documents and migration certificate (in case other state candidate), these will not be returned till course is finished.
9. The candidate shall submit 3 sets of attested photocopies of all documents and 10 passport size photographs (for photo: student must wear light coloured clothes sand background must be in white) at the time of admission.
10. Student admission will not be cancelled once joined, if student fails join after admission they will have to pay complete remaining amount for the entire course. Some Extra-ordinary circumstances will be exempted.
11. The rules are subject to change in accordance with the decision of management taken from time to time.

Sponsorship is a privilege, there by weightage is given to candidates during selection. Sponsored students are expected to understand the spirit of service, the care and compassion for the less fortunate, which is integral to Padhar Hospital.

**Details of Sponsorship:**

1. During selection, weightage is given to students sponsored by Diocese/Missionary organizations.
2. A specific declaration should be submitted by each sponsored candidate that he/she has no any amount as security bond/donation/deposit/retainer to the sponsoring body given other than the stipulated Rs. 300/- for registration. Any violation of this will make the candidate ineligible for admission.
3. Sponsorship will be on the basis of the needs of sponsoring agency to have trained personnel for their mission work. The sponsoring agency has to produce an undertaking that the post will be available when the candidate completes the study program.

**Facilities Available:****• Teaching Facilities**

The college of nursing is equipped with modern teaching Facilities as LCD Projector, Charts, O.H.P. slide, specimen Models and films. Field trips are made in connection with some courses. Medical faculty are called to teach in specialized area.

**• Clinical Facilities**

The clinical facilities of Padhar Hospital are excellent for the study and care of patients. The hospital has a capacity of 250 beds with all the clinical specialities. It offers services in General Medicine, General Surgery, and Orthopaedics. Ophthalmology, Paediatrics, Psychiatry, Dialysis Unit, ENT, Urology, Plastic & Oncology surgery, Maxillofacial Surgery, Radio therapy & Obstetrics and Gynaecology with Neonatal Intensive care unit, while students are posted in clinics. They are supervised by clinical instructors & Nursing Staff.



- **Hostel**

The hostel facilities are provided for students to those who are coming from out station. A modern building attractively and comfortably furnished, accommodates 150 students. The student must bring their own bedding and bed linen. Indoor and outdoor game facilities are provided. A visitor's room is available.



- **Library**

Library is the heart of an educational institute. It is where the students and faculty find answers to their questions. It is the place where the academicians quench their thirst for information and knowledge. The library is the place where a research scholar spends hours to find relevant literature to form basis for his/her enquiry and a young student finds interesting stories to divert from the monotony of text book mugging.

The library of college of Nursing Padhar hospital provides its readers all of above. There are about two thousand and five hundred books. Around ten Indian and five foreign journals are subscribed for the library. The books and journals and Periodicals are not only related to nursing but to myriad of subjects that the Students and faculty need to prepare for their assignments and projects. The reading rooms are properly lighted and well ventilated with Comfortable seating arrangements.

There is a full time qualified librarian to facilitate the Students in using the library facilities. The library remains open from 9 am. To 4 p.m.



- **Computer Lab**

The primary goal of the computer labs and classrooms is to provide Assistance to students that will enhance their chances of succeeding in technology-based classroom assignments and to provide access to equipment that will support the needs of instruction where we celebrate life-long learning. Keeping pace with the latest technology, we at college of nursing Padhar Hospital have a fully equipped computer lab with multimedia & full time internet facility.

Students are encouraged to utilize it to the maximum. Net connectively is also available to students without any extra charges. It is having audio-visual facilities with LCD projector to transform education with latest technology.

The computer labs support the curriculum of the college and the assignments of the instructor. Whenever any error occurs the concerned faculty/expert should be consulted. Students must save their work in the directory, separate for each student, to avoid problems such as deletion, unauthorized changes etc.



- **Audio Visual Aids Lab**

Audio Visuals Aids Lab is designed with different types of teaching aids to help the students to improve their knowledge & understanding. Some of the Audio Visual Aids are Television, Over Head Projector, LCD and Projector screens.

- **Nursing Foundation Lab**

The Nursing foundation lab is aimed at helping the students to acquire knowledge, understanding and skills and techniques of nursing and practice them in supervised settings. This lab plays a major role in nursing program. It has good infrastructure facilities:- Bed strength – 6, various types of mannequin, different types of articles and equipments for the demonstration of nursing procedures based on the requirement of the Indian Nursing Council.

- **Maternal & Child Health Nursing Lab**

The obstetrics and Child health Nursing laboratory is set up with the view to enable the students to provide the students to provide comprehensive care to the mothers, neonates and children. The infrastructure of the lab includes adult beds, paediatrics cots and different articles and instruments used in obstetrics and child health nursing. This will help the students to acquire knowledge and skills in patient care that are to be practiced in clinical settings.

- **Nutrition Lab**

The subject nutrition is to assist the students to acquire knowledge for maintenance of optimum health at different stages of life and its application in nursing. The Nutrition lab is well established with all facilities including gas stoves, refrigerators and variety of articles and vessels for the development of skills in preparation of different food items are present.



- **Community Health Experience**

As a part of study programme, students are posted in Rural and Urban areas as per the specification of Indian Nursing Council syllabus.

Padhar Hospital is involved in various types of outreach programs like:

- Cancer detection camp
- Cleft lip and cleft palate screening camp
- Eye screening camps
- Orthopaedic screening camps (post polio disabilities)
- HIV/AIDS awareness, testing and counselling programme
- Community based rehabilitation programme
- College screening Eye, Dental, and General Health Check Up
- Capacity building and networking

- **Anatomy & Physiology Lab:**

Anatomy Lab is developed to provide access to the models, microscope slides and dissection materials utilized in the anatomy and physiology lab at Nursing College.

- **Transport**

In order to facilitate convenient transportation, the institute maintains its own fleet of buses, which are available to the students as per the academic schedule.

- **Hostel & Mess**

Our college provides hostel and mess facilities for GIRLS & BOYS with comfortable and secure accommodation. The hostel complex houses a mess where hygienic and nutritious food is served to the students in a homely atmosphere. Students have to abide by the rules and regulations prescribed by the authorities and are expected to help in creating a home like atmosphere.

- **Vacation and Holidays**

As per the council rules and specification. Generally 4 week vacation, 10 days sick leave and gazetted holidays will be given as per the policy of Padhar hospital.

- **Attendance**

80% attendance in theory and 100% attendance in clinical is compulsory to be eligible for state council examination.

- **Health Service**

The college of nursing health services under the direction of the physician. Complete physical examinations are done on admission and yearly thereafter. Immunization is given whenever required. Special drugs, tonics, spectacles & dentures are to be obtained at personal expenses. Any excess leave will be deducted from the annual leave. Minimum amount will be charged for medical service on a yearly basis.



# Rules and Regulation of Hostel

1. Every student shall attend the study hours at 7:30 pm to 9:00 pm.
2. Student living in the hostel shall take permission from the principal of college of nursing for going out of hostel. Shopping pass will be allowed once in a month on 2<sup>nd</sup> Saturday.
3. At 7:00 pm every student must be in the hostel and shall not leave the hostel thereafter.
4. Lights should be put off at 11:00 pm; thereafter absolute silence shall prevail in the hostel.
5. Everyone in the hostel is responsible to keep the room neat and clean all the time.
6. The student shall be responsible to protect the hostel property such as chairs, tables, stools, benches which may be loaned to them.
7. Mobile is prohibited in the college campus, hospital & other clinical areas.
8. Mobile phones are not allowed to be used in hostel after 10:00 pm.
9. Parents/Guardians may visit only on Sunday between 8:00 am to 4:00 pm.
10. No family member or local guardian, male or female shall enter the hostel rooms. If anyone found, then disciplinary action will be taken against the student.
11. Meals in the hostel will be served only in the dining room, at the following time, breakfast 7:00 am, lunch 1:00 pm to 2:00 pm. And dinner 8:30 pm to 9:00 pm.
12. Hostel authorities shall not be held responsible for any loss of money or other valuable articles.
13. No electrical appliances are allowed in the hostel.

**COLLEGE OF NURSING PADHAR HOSPITAL IS NO RAGGING ZONE WITH ZERO TOLERANCE towards any incident of ragging, by preventing its occurrence and having appropriate measures to curb any incident of ragging.**

### **RAGGING IS PROHIBITED WHAT CONSTITUTES RAGGING**

Ragging is an act of aggression committed by an individual or group of individuals over another individual or a group of individuals where the first group, by virtue of their being senior to the second group, somehow gets the authority and audacity to commit the act and the second group,

By virtue of their being new to the institution are automatic victims. Any interaction which is aggressive and asymmetric is ragging. It is form of abuse on newcomers.

Ragging is not harmless fun. Students come from social and cultural backgrounds, and what may be harmless fun for some may turn out be serious indignity for some others. There are always a few cases where some fresher's find ragging (or interaction) intolerable and suffer loss of self esteem. **The types of ragging may include:**

- Any conduct by any student or students whether by words spoken or written or by an act which has the effect of teasing, treating or handling with rudeness a fresher or any other student.
- Annoyance, hardship, physical or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in any fresher or any other student due to indiscipline activity by any other student or group of students.
- Any act by a senior student that prevents disrupts or disturbs the regular academic activity of any other student or a fresher.
- Exploiting the services of a fresher or any other student for completing the academic tasks assigned to an individual or a group of students.
- Any act of financial extortion or forceful expenditure burden put on fresher or any other student.
- Any act of physical abuse including all its variants like obscene and lewd acts, gestures, danger to health, sexual or homosexual abuse etc., on fresher or any other student.
- Any act or abuse by spoken words, emails, posts, public insults which would also include deriving preventive pleasure, vicarious or sadistic thrill from activity or passively participating in causing discomfort to fresher or any other student.
- Act that affect mental health or self-confidence of fresher or any other student.
- Any other act as mentioned in regulation of UGC/Regulatory authorities like Nursing Council/Any other regulatory body and the regulation of Govt. of M.P

**PUNISHMENTS IN THE EVENT OF RAGGING ANY ONE OR MORE OF THE  
FOLLOWING PUNISHMENT MAY BEAWARDED NAMELY**

- Suspension from attending classes and academic privileges.
- Withholding/withdrawing scholarship/fellowship and other benefits.
- Debarring from appearing in any test/examination or other evaluation process.
- With holding results.
- Debarring from representing the University/instruction in any regional, national or international meet, tournament youth festival etc.
- Suspension/Expulsion from the hostel.
- Cancellation of admission.
- Rustication from the University/Instruction for period ranging from one to four semesters.
- Expulsion from the university/institution and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution for a specified period. Provided that where the persons committing or abetting the act of ragging are not identified the institution shall resort to collective punishment. A part from inviting any disciplinary action the erring student may also be subject to face any legal action as prescribed under the UGC/University regulations.
